## SACRAMENTO COUNTY TUBERCULOSIS CONTROL PROGRAM

The Sacramento County Tuberculosis Control Program is responsible for the surveillance, evaluation, and treatment of tuberculosis (TB) suspects and cases in Sacramento County. Clinical care for TB is provided at the Chest Clinic located at the Primary Care Center at 4600 Broadway in Sacramento. The County works closely with the healthcare community and public to identify and treat cases of active TB and their contacts, to prevent further spread of the disease. The primary duty of this position is the practice of medicine as a licensed physician specializing in the diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of TB in Sacramento County.

#### **Duties & Responsibilities**

- Examining, treating, and monitoring TB rule-outs, TB cases, and contacts, including adults and children with active TB disease or latent TB infection.
- Interpreting radiographic and lab results, prescribing and managing standard and alternative drug regimens for treatment of TB and drug-resistant TB, monitoring therapy, and managing complications.
- Documenting findings for reports submitted to the State Tuberculosis Control Program.
- Working with a diverse patient population.
- Evaluating immigration referrals and individuals seeking shelter clearance.
- Participating in regional and state trainings and meetings with the California Tuberculosis Controllers Association, tuberculosis care partners, and Curry International Tuberculosis Center.
- Working with a multi-disciplinary case management team, the Tuberculosis Controller, and the County Health Officer to manage cases and outbreaks.

#### **The Ideal Candidate**

**Experience:** At least 3 years in medical case management and experience in clinical practice and disease management, with preference for experience managing active TB disease.

**Education:** A Doctoral Degree in medicine and hold an unrestricted license to practice medicine in the State of California.
