


## CITC Update for CTCA Business Meeting

- CITC funded from 2018-2022 as a Tuberculosis Center of Excellence for Training, Education, and Medical Consultation (TB COE) for the western region, serving 17 jurisdictions
  - All TB COE educational products and webinars serve a national audience
  - o Archived webinars and products from all 4 TB COEs are available on one website
- CITC continues to provide expert medical consultation with our 29 consultants
  - Added in 2018: addition of longitudinal medical consultation, as needed
- CITC provides ongoing technical assistance to the region

- CITC coordinates 6 <u>mini-fellowships</u> each year, often partnering with different host jurisdictions. Virtual options are available for 2020/21.
