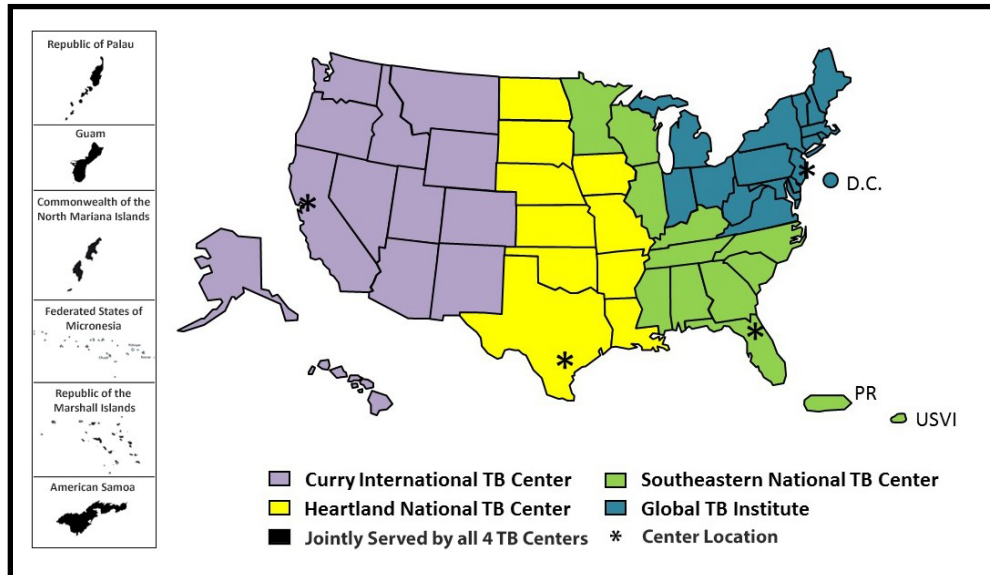


CITC Update for CTCA Business Meeting

- CITC funded from 2018-2022 as a Tuberculosis Center of Excellence for Training, Education, and Medical Consultation (TB COE) for the western region, serving 17 jurisdictions
 - Notification for the 2023-2027 TB COE funding cycle expected early December
 - All TB COE educational products and webinars serve a national audience

 - CITC continues to provide **expert [medical consultation](#)** with our 32 consultants
 - Recently added pharmacology, radiology, and laboratory consultants (thank you **Dr. Zenda Berrada** and **Dr. Varvara Kozyreva**)
 - Ongoing, **longitudinal medical consultation** available for complex cases, as needed, includes **drug acquisition** support for TB Programs
 - CITC provides ongoing **technical assistance** to the region
