


## CITC Update for CTCA Business Meeting

October 24, 2022



- CITC funded from 2018-2022 as a Tuberculosis Center of Excellence for Training, Education, and Medical Consultation (TB COE) for the western region, serving 17 jurisdictions
  - Notification for the 2023-2027 TB COE funding cycle expected early December
  - o All TB COE educational products and webinars serve a national audience
  - o Archived webinars and products from all 4 TB COEs are available on one website
- CITC continues to provide expert medical consultation with our 32 consultants
  - Recently added pharmacology, radiology, and laboratory consultants (thank you Dr. Zenda Berrada and Dr. Varvara Kozyreva)
  - Ongoing, longitudinal medical consultation available for complex cases, as needed, includes drug acquisition support for TB Programs
- CITC provides ongoing **technical assistance** to the region

- CITC coordinates 6 <u>mini-fellowships</u> each year, often partnering with different host jurisdictions. Includes both virtual and in-person options. Application for 2023 expected to be available in December 2022

  - New! Collaboration with CDPH TBCB, TB Free CA, GTBI, and CITC: Rifamycin Drug-Drug Interactions: A Guide for Primary Care Providers Treating Latent Tuberculosis Infection (December 2022)
  - Released April 2022, in partnership with CDPH TBCB: Updated <u>Tuberculosis Contact</u> Investigation in Schools Toolkit
