For Ukrainian Arrivers – DPH healthcare services are available at:

Department of Public Health Refugee Health Assessment Program (RHAP)

Comprehensive medical assessment including labs, physical exams, immunizations (if eligible), and referrals to primary care and mental health services.

Public Health Center Clinics – 7 locations

Nurse walk-ins for immunizations and TB testing.
Chest clinics for TB services.

Community TB Testing Events

Monthly testing events.
\$20 gift card at testing events and health center.
